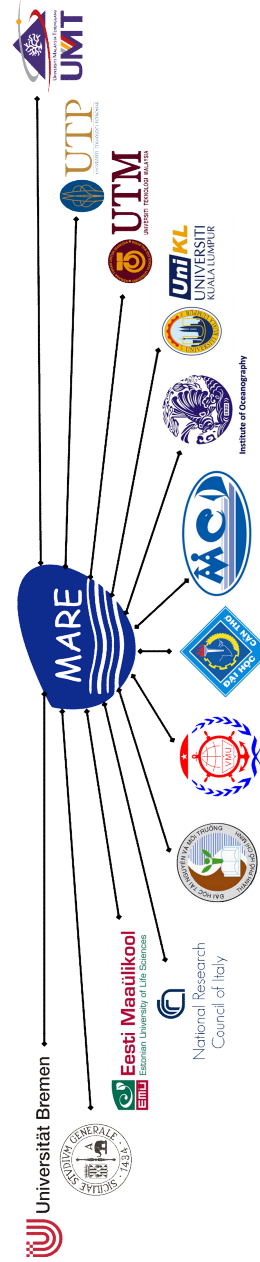


PROJECT AIMS
